


The Charles and Joseph Privensal family lived in the same house in Mount Tabor, on Manchester Road, until 1915, when Charles and his family moved to Bennington, and Joseph and his family moved to Hartford, Connecticut. This means that Clifford and Albert grew up together in Mount Tabor. Aunt Eunice (Eunice Provensal Grise) lived with the Joseph Privensal family in the 1930s when she first went to Connecticut.

Albert Joseph Privensal, son of Joseph Privensal and 1st cousin of Clifford Provensal would occasionally come up to Bennington from Hartford (before he left for the War) to visit Clip and Imogene Provensal. Both Mom and Dad would talk about this frequently. Following her father's footsteps, Al's daughter, Gayle Privensal DiPillo, came up from Hartford one last time in September, 2006 for a final visit.

Gayle Privensal DiPillo says about her father AI, "I have heard many stories about him and his amazing athletic endeavors. It seems as if every where I go someone knew him and to this day still raves about the man. I guess every loved him. Gen tells me he was 'an uncommon man in a common world" ".

Al Privensal was described in the book "We Flew Without Guns" as follows:

"Everybody in the world ought to have a friend like Al Privensal. It would be good for their nerves and their digestion and their outlook on life. He just plain didn't give a damn. No matter what the circumstances at any given time, his attitude was always: so what? If he wanted a drink, he took it. If he wanted ten drinks, he took them — and maybe a couple more to boot. If he had to get up next morning for an important meeting, all right, he would get up — if he felt like it."
